- A speed limit of 5mph is in force on all parts of the event field at all times please
- Please do not bring any oxyacetylene equipment onto the field at any time.
- The law requires petrol to be stored in approved containers with a maximum content of 5lt (plastic can) 10lt (steel can).
- Please <u>do not</u> arrive on site before midday on Friday 30th August unless prior arrangements have been made with us and <u>do</u> depart before midday on Monday 2nd September.
- All exhibits **must** follow the NVTEC Safety Code.
- All persons driving a vehicle on the field **must** hold a current driving license.
- Passengers are **not permitted** on moving tractors regardless of the number of seats fitted.
- **Do** please book in on arrival and pay entry fee.
- **Do** please park caravans, tents, etc. as requested and ensure access is left for emergency vehicles. (6m between walls) **Do** please clear up any rubbish. Bins will be provided for general rubbish.
- **Do** please keep dogs on a lead and clean up after them.
- Do please note this event is not exempted under the "Off Road Provisions of the Road Traffic Act".
- **Do** please consider other exhibitors when running generators.
- The Organiser's reserve the right, at their sole discretion, to expel any person from the event.
- All exhibitors are responsible for having their own public liability insurance policy.
- There is a chemical disposal tank located on the field.
- There are toilet facilities in provided by Carter accommodation.
- Mr Mason has kindly allowed us to use his lovely field so please do respect it, thank you.
