Guidance Notes for Traders and Exhibitors

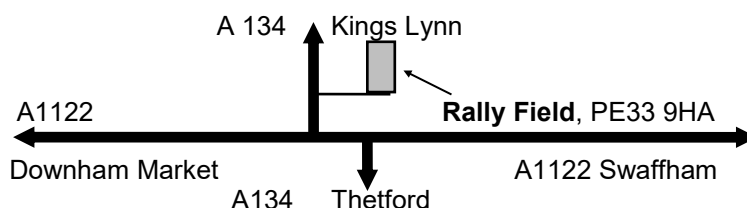
The following guidelines may appear a little blunt but they are there to ensure a safe enjoyable and successful rally for all involved. Your co-operation would be appreciated and is expected in following them.

- A speed limit of 5mph is in force on all parts of the rally field at all times
- All exhibitors and traders are advised to carry a serviceable **dry powder fire extinguisher** of at least 2kg capacity.
- Please do not bring any oxyacetylene equipment onto the rally field at any time.
- The law requires petrol to be stored in approved containers with a maximum content of 5lt (plastic can) 10lt (steel can).
- Please **do not** arrive on site before 9.00am on Friday 1st May unless prior arrangements have been made with your section steward and **do** depart before midday on Tuesday 5th May.
- All exhibits/traders **must** be in situ (i.e. on the peg) on the rally field by 9.30am each day
- All exhibits/traders **must** remain in situ (i.e. on the peg) on the rally field until 5.00pm Sunday & 4.00pm Monday.
- All exhibits **must** follow the NVTEC Safety Code. Copies available on request.
- Vehicles **must not move on the public area of the rally field**, during hours of public access, **unless authorised by a steward.**
Please save your fuel by not starting your exhibit too early and please wait to be instructed to move
- All persons driving a vehicle on the rally field **must** hold a current driving license.
- Passengers are **not permitted** on moving tractors regardless of the number of seats fitted.
- Any tractor that has been **modified** with a non agricultural engine that has a maximum engine speed **over** 2700 RPM needs to have suitable protection over the clutch housing in case of flywheel failure this can be in the form of a clutch shatter blanket or 10mm steel plate protection all the way round the housing and the tractor must also be correctly insured and registered with the modifications. *For any further information required on the topic please contact Tom Venni 07557910246*
- **Exhibitors must not** interfere with, or dismantle safety fences at any time.
- **Do** please book in with your section steward on arrival. This will avoid queues on show days.
- **Do** please display your exhibit number & log sheet on your exhibit. It helps the judges and commentators.
- **Do** please park caravans, tents, etc. as requested and ensure access is left for emergency vehicles. (6m between walls)
Do please clear up any rubbish. Skips and bins will be provided for general rubbish. **Traders are expected to take their commercial waste (e.g. cardboard etc.) away when they leave.**
- **Please take responsibility for your pets.** Please keep them on a lead, please do not allow them to bark constantly and clean up after them.
- **Do** please note the parade times and be ready to join in as requested by stewards.
- **Do** please note this rally is **not** exempted under the "Off Road Provisions of the Road Traffic Act".
- **Do** please consider other exhibitors when running generators in camping areas during the day and night. Please try not to run your generators between the hours of 10.00pm and 8.00am unless absolutely necessary.
- The Rally Organiser's reserve the right, at their sole discretion, to expel any person from the Rally Field.
- All traders are responsible for the safe and correct erection of their trade stalls.
- All exhibitors and traders are responsible for having their own public liability insurance policy
- Trading of any form without the permission of the organisers is forbidden and may result in expulsion from the site
- In the event of a section being oversubscribed pitches will be allocated in the order they were booked
- Judging will take place on Sunday 3rd May - PLEASE DISPLAY YOUR NUMBER FOR JUDGING.
- **Grand Ring Parades** - daily - actual running order from section stewards.
- A **Licensed Bar** has been applied for.
- **Caterers** will be on site.
- **Stationary Engines.** Please note we are **not providing** a water bowser for **filling engines**
- There are shopping facilities in Downham Market, Swaffham and Kings Lynn. Please ask if you need help.
- The rally will be signposted locally but the map may be of some help to you.
- Steam Engines water and coal will be provided.

Thank you for attending and if you require any further help please do ask.

We all look forward to making new acquaintances and meeting old friends but above all wish you a successful and enjoyable rally.
